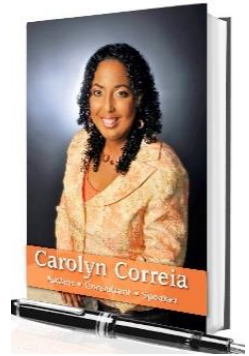


Carolyn Correia is an author, speaker, communications consultant and freelance journalist with 100+ articles published globally.
